SIZE One Size

## KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

22"/56 cm circumference

## MATERIALS

- 2 balls S . Charles Collezione TINKA $100 \%$ fine merino wool ( $1.75 \mathrm{oz} / 50 \mathrm{~g}$; 108yds/100m) in color \#10 ebony (A)
- 2 balls S. Charles Collezione NATASHA $38 \%$ wool, $33 \%$ acrylic, $24 \%$ alpaca, $5 \%$ nylon ( $1.75 \mathrm{oz} / 50 \mathrm{~g} ; 38 \mathrm{yds} / 35 \mathrm{~m}$ ) in color \#03 ebony (B)
- One pair size 11 ( 8 mm ) needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- One pair size 15 (10mm) needles
- Yarn needle


## GAUGE

12 sts and 15 rows $=4 " / 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in k2, p3 rib using smaller needles and 2 strands of A held together 8 sts and 12 rows $=4 " / 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in Stockinette stitch using larger needles and B
TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

## SPECIAL TERMS

M1: Make 1 (inc) - Lift strand between needles to left-hand needle and work strand through the back loop, twisting it to prevent a hole, [knit or purl as indicated by pattern st].

## PATTERN STITCHES

Stockinette stitch (St st)
P3, k2 rib (multiple of 5 sts)
Rev Stockinette stitch (Rev St st) Purl on RS, knit on WS.

## BRIM

Using larger needles and 2 strands of
A held together, cast on 6 sts.
Shape Brim
Row 1 (RS): P4, k1, p1.
Row 2: Slip 1, M1, p1, k4-7 sts.
Row 3: Slip 1, p3, k2, p1.
Row 4: Slip 1, M1, p2, k4-8 sts.
Row 5: Slip 1, p3, k2, p2.
Row 6: Slip 1, M1, k1, p2, k4-9 sts.
Row 7: Slip 1, p3, k2, p3.
Row 8: Slip 1, M1, k2, p2, k4-10 sts.
Row 9: Slip 1, p3, k2, p4.
Row 10: Slip 1, M1, k3, p2, k4-11 sts.
Row 11: Slip 1, p3, k2, p3, k1, p1.

Row 12: Slip 1, M1, p1, k3, p2, k4 12 sts.
Row 13: Slip 1, [p3, k2] twice, p1.
Row 14: Slip 1, M1, p2, k3, p2, k4 13 sts.
Row 15: Slip 1, [p3, k2] twice, p2.
Row 16: Slip 1, M1, k1, p2, k3, p2, k4 - 14 sts.

Row 17: Slip 1, [p3, k2] twice, p3.
Row 18: Slip 1, M1, k2, p2, k3, p2, k4 - 15 sts.

Row 19: Slip 1, [p3, k2] twice, p4.
Row 20: Slip 1, M1, [k3, p2] twice, k4 16 sts.
Row 21: Slip 1, [p3, k2] twice, p3, k1, p1.
Row 22: Slip 1, M1, p1, [k3, p2] twice, k4-17 sts.
Row 23: Slip 1, [p3, k2] 3 times, p1.
Row 24: Slip 1, M1, [p2, k3] 3 times, k1-18 sts.
Row 25: Slip 1, [p3, k2] 3 times, p2.
Row 26: Slip 1, M1, k1, [p2, k3] 3
times, k1 - 19 sts.
Row 27: Slip 1, [p3, k2] 3 times, p3.
Row 28: Slip 1, M1, k2, [p2, k3] 3
times, k1-20 sts.
Row 29: Slip 1, [p3, k2] 3 times, p4.
Row 30: Slip 1, [k3, p2] 3 times, k4.
Rep Rows 29 and 30 until piece measures 14 1/2" from beginning, end with a RS row.

## Shape Brim

(WS) Dec 1 st this row, then every other row 13 times, as follows: P2tog, work to end -6 sts rem. Bind off in rib.

## CROWN

With RS of BRIM facing, using smaller needles and 2 strands of $A$ held
together, pick up and knit 58 sts along left-hand (shaped) edge of BRIM. Purl 1 row.
(RS) Change to larger needles, $B$, and Rev St st; work even for 5 rows.

## Shape Crown

Dec Row 1 (WS): K1, *k2tog, k2; rep from * to last st, k1 - 44 sts rem. Work even for 3 rows.

Dec Row 2 (WS): K1, *k2tog, k1; rep from * to last st, k1 - 30 sts rem. Work even for 3 rows.
Dec Row 3 (WS): K1, *k2tog; rep from * to last st, k1 - 16 sts rem. Work even for 1 row.
Dec Row 4 (WS): *K2tog; rep from * to end - 8 sts rem. Break yarn, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off. Sew back seam.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
