1 ball **BERROCO SOX** (100 grs),
#1404 Padarn
1 set (4) double pointed knitting
needles (dpns), size 3 (3.25 mm) OR
SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
5 st markers (1 a different color for
beg-of-rnd)
Waste yarn to hold sts
Tapestry needle

30 sts and 40 rnds = 4" in St st

PATTERN STITCH (Multiple of 7 sts)

Rnds 1, 2 and 3: * K5, p2, rep from * around.

Rnd 4: * K2tog, yo, k1, yo, SSK, p2, rep from * around. Rep these 4 rnds for Pat St.

RIGHT GLOVE

Cast on 70 sts. Divide sts onto 3 dpns, place marker and join for working in the round. Work even in Pat St for 3", end with Rnd 4, 4 sts before marker.

Next Rnd: Pm (this is now the beg of rnd), k2, pm, p2, work Rnd 1 of Pat St over 28 sts, pm, k6, k2tog, (k4, k2tog) 5 times – 64 sts. Work even, keeping 30 sts between markers in pat as established and remaining sts in St st (knit EVERY rnd) until piece measures 5" from beg.

Thumb Gusset: Work to 2nd marker, k1, pm, M1L, k2, M1R, pm, knit to end – 66 sts (4 sts between markers for thumb gusset). Work even for 3 rnds.

Inc Rnd: Work to 2nd marker, k1, sm, M1L, knit to next marker, M1R, sm, knit to end – 68 sts (6 sts in thumb gusset). Rep Inc Rnd every 4th rnd 7 times more – 82 sts (20 sts in thumb gusset).

Hand: Next Rnd: Work to 3rd marker, drop marker, sl 20 sts of thumb gusset to waste yarn for thumb, drop marker, cast on 2 sts, knit to end - 64 sts. Work even in pat as established until piece reaches ½" below the base of your fingers.

Dec Rnd: (K5, k2tog) 4 times, knit to end – 60 sts. Work even in St st on ALL sts until piece reaches the base of your fingers.

Little Finger: K6, k2tog, sl 46 sts to waste yarn, cast on 3 sts, sl the last 6 sts from waste yarn to dpn and knit these 6 sts – 16 sts. Rearrange sts more evenly on 3 needles, pm and join for working in the round. Work even in St st until finger measures ½" less than desired length.

Dec Rnd: * K2tog, rep from * around – 8 sts. Knit 1 rnd. Rep Dec Rnd once more. Break off yarn leaving an 8" long end. Thread end into tapestry needle and



draw through all sts on needles. Pull up tightly and secure. Fasten off.

Ring Finger: Sl 7 sts from waste yarn to dpn. Join yarn and work these as k5, k2tog, cast on 3 sts, sl the last 7 sts from waste yarn to another dpn and work these as k2tog, k5, pick up and knit 3 sts across cast-on sts of Little Finger – 18 sts. Rearrange sts more evenly on 3 needles, pm and join for working in the round. Work even in St st until finger measures ½" less than desired length.

Dec Rnd 1: * K2tog, rep from * around – 9 sts. Knit 1 rnd.

Dec Rnd 2: K1, * k2tog, rep from * around – 5 sts. Break off yarn leaving an 8" long end. Thread end into tapestry needle and draw through all sts on needles. Pull up tightly and secure. Fasten off.

Middle Finger: Sl 7 sts from waste yarn to dpn, join yarn and work these as k5, k2tog, cast on 3 sts, sl last 8 sts from waste yarn to dpn and work these as k2tog, k6, pick up and knit 4 sts across cast-on sts of Ring Finger – 20 sts. Complete as for Little Finger, ending with 5 sts.

Index Finger: Sl 17 sts from waste yarn to dpns. Join yarn and knit these sts, pick up and knit 3 sts

across cast-on sts of Middle Finger – 20 sts. Complete as for Middle Finger.

Thumb: Sl 20 sts from waste yarn to dpns and divide sts onto 3 needles. Join yarn and k20, then pick up and knit 1 st before cast-on sts, 2 sts across cast-on sts, then 1 st after cast-on sts – 24 sts. Pm and join for working in the round. Complete as for Little Finger, ending with 6 sts.

LEFT GLOVE

Work as for Right Glove for 3", end with Rnd 4 of Pat St – 70 sts.

Next Rnd: K2, pm (this is now the beg of rnd), k2tog, (k4, k2tog) 5 times, k6, pm, p2, work Rnd 1 of Pat St over 28 sts, pm, k2 – 64 sts. Work even, keeping 30 sts between markers in pat as established and remaining sts in St st (knit EVERY rnd) until piece measures 5" from beg.

Thumb Gusset: Work to 3 sts before first marker, pm, M1L, k2, M1R, pm, work in pat as established to end – 66 sts (4 sts between markers for thumb gusset). Work even for 3 rnds.

Inc Rnd: Work to first marker, sm, M1L, knit to next marker, M1R, sm, work to end – 68 sts (6 sts in thumb gusset). Rep Inc Rnd every 4th rnd 7 times more – 82 sts (20 sts in thumb gusset).

Hand: Next Rnd: Work to first marker, drop marker, sl 20 sts of thumb gusset to waste yarn for thumb, drop marker, cast on 2 sts, work to end – 64 sts. Work even in pat as established until piece reaches ½" below the base of your fingers.

Dec Rnd: K32, (k5, k2tog) 4 times, knit to end – 60 sts. Work even in St st on ALL sts until piece reaches the base of your fingers. Complete as for Right Glove.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning
CC: contrasting color
cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.
cn: cable needle
cont: continue
dec: decrease
dpn: double pointed needles
est: established
inc: increase
K: knit
k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)
k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together
k3tog: Knit 3 stitches together
LH: left hand
MC: main color
M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1L: Work as for M1.
M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1pL: Work as for M1p.
M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
p: purl
p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
pssso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together
p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch
p3tog: purl 3 stitches together
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip

sm: slip marker
SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.
SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.
st(s): stitch(es)
TBL: through back loop(s)
tog: together
w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. With yarn held in back, slip stitch to be wrapped purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle, then bring the yarn to the back again. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.
WS: wrong side
wyib: with yarn in back
wyif: with yarn in front
yo: yarn over
end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.
end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row
Stockinette stitch (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.
Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.
GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.
