

Monster Mash by DROPS Design

Knitted socks in DROPS Delight. Size 35 to 43

DROPS design: Pattern de-219

Yarn group A

SIZE:

35/37 - 38/40 - 41/43

Foot length: approx. 22 - 24 - 27 cm

MATERIALS:

DROPS DELIGHT from Garnstudio (belongs to yarn group A) 100-100-100 g colour 16, green/blue

One pair of socks weighs 52 grams in size 35/37. Begin a new ball for each sock to avoid colour differences when switching yarn.

KNITTING TENSION:

26 stitches in width and 34 rows vertically in stocking stitch = 10×10 cm.

NEEDLES:

DROPS DOUBLE POINTED NEEDLES SIZE 2.5 mm Needle size is only a suggestion! If you have too many stitches on 10 cm switch to a larger needle size. If you have too few stitches on 10 cm switch to a smaller needle size.



DROPS 214-55

Pattern for DROPS 214-55
EXPLANATION FOR THE PATTERN:
HEEL DECREASE: ROW 1 (= right side): Knit until 7-8-8 stitches remain, slip next stitch as if to knit, knit 1, pass slipped stitch over stitch knitted, turn piece. ROW 2 (= wrong side): Purl until 7-8-8 stitches remain, slip next stitch as if to purl, purl 1, pass slipped stitch over stitch purled, turn piece. ROW 3 (= right side): Knit until 6-7-7 stitches remain, slip next stitch as if to knit, knit 1, pass slipped stitch over stitch knitted, turn piece. ROW 4 (= wrong side): Purl until 6-7-7 stitches remain, slip next stitch as if to purl, purl 1, pass slipped stitch over stitch purled, turn piece. Continue decrease like this with 1 stitch less before each decrease until there are 14-14-16 stitches on needle.
START THE PIECE HERE:

SOCK - SHORT SUMMARY OF PIECE:

Work piece top down, work in the round on double pointed needle down to heel. Work heel back and forth before working in the round until foot is finished.

Cast on 60-64-68 stitches on double pointed needles size 2.5 mm with Delight. Work 1 round in stocking stitch. Continue with rib = knit 2/purl 2 for 4 cm. Then work in stocking stitch – AT THE SAME TIME on 1st round decrease 6-6-6 stitches evenly = 54-58-62 stitches.

REMEMBER THE KNITTING TENSION!


When piece measures 12-14-16 cm, keep the first 26-28-30 stitches on needle for heel, and slip the last 28-30-32 stitches on 1 stitch holder (= mid on top of foot). Work in stocking stitch back and forth over heel stitches for 5-5½-6 cm. Insert 1 marker in the piece. Now work HEEL DECREASE - read explanation above. After heel decrease, pick up 13-14-16 stitches on each side of heel, and slip the 28-30-32 stitches from stitch holder back on needle = 68-72-80 stitches. Insert 1 marker on each side of the 28-30-32 stitches on top of foot. Continue with stocking stitch in the round - AT THE SAME TIME decrease in each side as follows: Knit the last 2 stitches before first marker on top of foot twisted together, and knit the first 2 stitches after last marker on top of foot together. Repeat decreases every other round a total of 8-8-10 times = 52-56-60 stitches. Work until piece measures 18-19-21 cm from marker on heel (=

4-5-6 cm remain). Insert 1 marker in each side so that there are 26-28-30 stitches both on top of foot and under foot. Continue working stocking stitch while AT THE SAME TIME decreasing for toes on each side of both markers as follows:

Before marker: Knit 2 together. After marker: Knit 2 twisted together. Repeat decrease in each side on every other round a total of 4-7-9 times, and then on every round a total of 6-3-2 times = 12-16-16 stitches remain on needle. On next round work all stitches together 2 by 2. Cut the yarn and pull it through the remaining stitches, tighten together and fasten. Knit another sock the same way.
