Pluff Pluff Baby Blanket

Skill Level:

Easy

Size:

36" (92 cm) wide X 42" (107 cm) long

Materials:

Cascade Yarns® Pluff 100% Polyester

200 g (7.05 oz) / 262 yds (240 m)

3 skeins color #4 (Mint)

US 10 (6.0 mm)/36" Knitting Needle or

size to obtain gauge

Yarn Needle

Gauge:

11 sts x 18 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Stockinette st, unblocked.

Abbreviations:

BO = Bind Off
CO = Cast On
K = Knit
P = Purl
St(s) = Stitch(es)

Stockinette Pattern:

Row 1: K Row 2: P

Repeat these two rows to form pattern.

Garter Stitch Pattern:

Row 1-4: K every row.

Note: Chenille yarn sometimes will worm, or coil on itself. To prevent this from happening when working the Stockinette st knit rows, knit a few sts and then pull work in a downward motion to even sts out.

Begin Pattern:

Note: Pattern is worked in rows.

CO 99 sts using Long Tail CO method. Being careful to not CO your sts tightly.

Begin Garter St Border

Rows 1-4: Kall sts.

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Main Pattern:

Row 1: Kall sts.

Row 2: Pall sts.

Row 3: K all sts.

Row 4: Pall sts.

Row 5: K all sts.

Row 6: P all sts.

Row 7: K all sts.

Row 8: P all sts.

Row 9: K all sts.

Row 10: K all sts.

Row 11: K all sts.

Row 12: K all sts.

Repeat these 12 rows of pattern 18 times.

Your work should measure approximately 42" (107cm) in length.

Finishing:

BO off sts loosely.

Weave in ends using yarn needle.

Block if necessary.
