DROPS number 116-15

Set comprises: Knitted DROPS hat in English rib and scarf with cables in "Polaris".

" - Perfect for winter for all lovers of trendy hats!"

HAT:

Size: S/M - L

Head circumference: approx 54/56 - 58 cm / 21 1/4"/22" - 22

3/4'

Materials: DROPS POLARIS from Garnstudio 200-200 g color no 04, medium gray

CIRCULAR NEEDLE (80 cm / 32") size 15 mm/US 19 – or size needed to get 6 sts x 8 rows in English rib = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ / 4" x 4". DROPS CIRCULAR NEEDLE (80 cm / 32") size 10 mm/US 15 - for rib.

SCARF:

Measurements: approx 33 x 180 cm / 13" x 70 3/4" Materials: DROPS POLARIS from Garnstudio 600 g color no 04, medium gray

CIRCULAR NEEDLE (80 cm / 32") size 15 mm/US 19 – or size needed to get 7 sts x 8 rows in stockinette st = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ / 4" x 4".

All measurements in charts are in cm. For conversion from cm to inch - click here. There are different terms for crocheting in British and American English.

Pattern:

HAT:

GARTER ST (back and forth on needle): K all rows.

ENGLISH RIB (back and forth on needle):

Row 1: 1 garter st, * K1, 1 YO, slip next st as if to P *, repeat from *-* until 2 sts remain, finish with K1 and 1 garter st.

Row 2: 1 garter st, * 1 YO, slip 1 st as if to P, K tog YO and slipped st*, repeat from *-* until 2 sts remain, finish with 1 YO, slip 1 st as if to P, 1 garter st.

Row 3: 1 garter st, * K tog YO and slipped st, 1 YO, slip 1 st as if to P * repeat from *-* until 3 sts remain, K tog YO and slipped st, 1 garter st.

Repeat row 2 and 3.

NEW BALL TIP: When changing to a new ball, split the thread ends, moisten and twist them.

HAT PATTERN: Worked back and forth on circular needle. Cast on 27-29 sts on circular needle size 10 mm / US 15 with Polaris. P 1 row from WS, and continue in rib from RS as follows: 1 GARTER ST – see above, rib K1/P1 until 2 sts remain, finish with K1 and 1 garter st. Continue in rib until piece measures 7 cm / 2¾" (last row worked from WS). Change to circular needle size 15 mm / US 19 and continue in ENGLISH RIB on next row from RS – see above! REMEMBER THE GAUGE! See NEW BALL TIP!

When piece measures 26-28 cm / 10 1/4"-11" work 1 row stockinette st with 1 garter st each side, AT THE SAME TIME K3 tog across the row = 14-15 sts. Cut the thread, pull through remaining sts, tighten and fasten. Sew hat tog, edge to edge.

SCARF:

GARTER ST (back and forth on needle): K all rows.

PATTERN: See diagram M.1 and M.2. Diagram shows the pattern from RS.

SCARF PATTERN: Worked back and forth on circular needle. Cast on 23 sts on circular needle size 15 mm / US 19 with Polaris. Work GARTER ST on all sts - see above – until piece measures 10 cm / 4", AT THE SAME TIME on last row from WS inc 4 sts evenly = 27 sts. Continue as follows from RS: 6 garter sts, P1, M.1 (= 6 sts), P1, M.2 (= 6 sts), finish with P1 and 6 garter sts = 27 sts. (sts P from RS, K from WS). REMEMBER THE GAUGE! Continue in pattern like this. When piece measures approx 170 cm / $66\ 3/4$ " (adjust to after 1 full repeat), work garter st on all sts, AT THE SAME TIME dec 4 sts evenly on first row = 23 sts. Bind off when piece measures approx 180 cm / 70 3/4" (adjust to after 10 cm / 4" garter st).
