# Tahki Yarns



## **TEAK SCARF & HAT** designed by Teresa Chorzepa



SIZE One Size

## **KNITTED MEASUREMENTS**

Scarf 55"/140 cm long Hat 18"/45.5 cm circumference

## MATERIALS FOR SCARF

• 3 skeins Tahki Yarns **RIO**, 50% alpaca, 35% merino wool, 15% silk, (1.75oz/50g; 87yds/80m) in **color #03 red oak** 

## **FOR HAT**

2 skeins Tahki Yarns RIO, 50% alpaca, 35% merino wool, 15% silk, (1.75oz/50g; 87yds/80m) in color #03 red oak

## **MATERIALS FOR HAT (cont.)**

- One size 9 (5.5mm) circular needle, 16"/40 cm long
- Stitch markers

## **FOR BOTH SCARF & HAT**

- One pair size 10 (6mm) needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- Yarn needle

#### **GAUGE**

16 sts and 20 rows in Pattern stitch using size 10 needles

#### TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

## **SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS**

**K2tog:** Knit 2 together (dec) – Knit 2 sts tog through the front loops.

**P2tog:** Purl 2 together (dec) – Purl 2 sts tog through the front loops.

M1: Make 1 (inc) – Lift strand between needles to LH needle and work strand through the back loop, twisting it to prevent a hole, [knit or purl as indicated by pattern st].

M2: Make 2 (2 sts inc) – Lift strand between needles to LH needle and work strand through the back loop, twisting it to prevent a hole, then through the front loop to make 2nd st [knit or purl as indicated by pattern st].

#### **PATTERN STITCHES**

Garter Stitch Worked in rnds

Knit 1 round, purl 1 round. Repeat last 2 rounds for Garter st.

Pattern Stitch
Rows 1 and 3 (RS) Knit.
Rows 2 and 4 Purl.
Row 5 and 7 Purl.
Rows 6 and 8 Knit.
Repeat Rows 1-8 for Pattern st.

#### **SCARF**

With larger needles, cast on 32 sts. Rows 1 and 3 (WS) Purl. Rows 2 and 4 K1, k2tog, knit to last st, M1, k1. Row 5 and 7 Knit.

Rows 6 and 8 P1, p2tog, purl to last st, M1, p1.

Rep Rows 1-8 until piece measures 55" from beg, end with Row 8. Bind off.

#### HAT

### Part 1

With larger needles, cast on 2 sts. Beg with WS row, purl across.

**Row 1 (RS)** K1, M2, k1 - 4 sts.

Rows 2 and 4 Purl.

**Row 3** K3, M1, k1 - 5 sts.

**Row 5** P4, M2, k1 - 7 sts.

Rows 6 and 8 Knit.

**Row 7** P6, M1, k1 – 8 sts.

Row 9 Knit to last st, M2, k1.

Rows 10 and 12 Purl.

Row 11 Knit to last st, M1, k1.

Row 13 Purl to last st, M2, k1.

Rows 14 and 16 Knit.

Row 15 Purl to last st, M1, k1.

Rep Rows 9-16 for 4 more times – 38 sts. Beg with Row 1, rep Rows 1-8 of Pattern st for 18 rows.

### Shape Top

**Next Row (RS)** Bind off 19 sts, knit rem sts – 19 sts rem.

Work in Pattern st on 19 sts for 21 more rows, end on Row 8 of Pattern st. Bind off.

#### Part 2

With RS facing and larger needles, pick up and knit 31 sts along straight edge of Part 1, end on same row as last increase. Purl 1 row.

**Row 1 (RS)** P1, M2, purl to end of row – 33 sts.

Rows 2 and 4 Knit.

**Row 3** P1, M1, purl to end of row – 34 sts.

**Row 5** K1, M2, knit to end of row – 36 sts.

Rows 6 and 8 Purl.

**Row 7** K1, M1, knit to end of row – 37 sts. Rep Rows 1-8 once, then Rows 1-7 once – 49 sts.

## **Shape Top**

**Row 8 (WS)** Bind off 19 sts, purl to end of row – 30 sts rem.

Rep Rows 1-8 twice, then Rows 1-7 once – 48 sts.

Bind off.

#### FINISHING

Following Assembly Diagram, fold and sew edges of Hat together.

#### Brim

With RS facing and smaller circular needle, pick up and knit 72 sts around lower edge of HAT. Join to work in rnds. Pm for beg of rnd.

[Purl 1 rnd, knit 1 rnd] for Garter st for 8 rnds. Bind off.

Weave in ends.
