Knitted socks in DROPS BabyMerino. Piece is knitted top down with lace pattern and rib. Size 35 - 43

Size: 35/37 – 38/40 – 41/43 Leg length: 15-16-17 cm Materials: DROPS BABY MERINO from Garnstudio (belongs to yarn group A) 100-100-100 g colour 09, lime

ACCESSORIES FOR THE PIECE:

KNITTING TENSION: 26 stitches in width and 34 rows vertically in stocking stitch = 10×10 cm. 33 stitches in width and 40 rows vertically with rib (= knit 1/purl 1) = 10×10 cm.

NEEDLES:

DOUBLE POINTED NEEDLES SIZE 2.5 mm Needle size is only a suggestion! If you have too many stitches on 10 cm switch to larger needles. If you have too few stitches on 10 cm switch to smaller needles.

You may also do Magic Loop and use circular needles.

EXPLANATION FOR THE PATTERN:

PATTERN: See diagram A.1. Choose diagram for your size.

START THE PIECE HERE:

SOCKS - SHORT OVERVIEW OF THE PIECE: Worked in the round on double pointed needles, top down.

SOCK:

Cast on 64-72-80 stitches on double pointed needles size 2.5 mm with Baby Merino. Knit 1 round. Then work rib (= purl 1/knit 1) for 2-3-4 cm. Now work pattern as follows (choose diagram for your size): A.1 (= 33-37-41 stitches), continue with rib as before over the remaining stitches. Repeat pattern vertically. REMEMBER THE KNITTING TENSION! When 2 repetitions of A.1 have been worked vertically (piece measures approx. 10-11-12 cm), work as follows: Work A.1 as before over the first 33-37-41 stitches (= on top of foot), cast off the next 31-35-39 stitches with knit over knit and purl over purl (= back of foot). Work next round as follows: Work pattern as before over A.1, cast on 25-31-35 new stitches (= under foot) = 58-68-76 stitches. NOW MEASURE PIECE FROM HERE! Continue with A.1 and rib. When 2-2-3 repetitions of A.1 have been worked vertically from cast off and cast on of new stitch (= 4-4-5 repetitions in total from cast-on edge) continue with knit over knit and purl over purl. Fasten off. Work the other sock the same way.

 $\Box = knit$


= purl

= between 2 stitches make 1 yarn over. On next round purl or knit yarn over - see next round in diagram. They should make holes.


=knit 2 together

= slip 1 stitch knitwise, knit 1, pass slipped stitch over stitch worked
